Any information found on the internet must be put in your own words if you are planning on including it in your paper. You will receive a mark of 0 for any plagiarized work. **Do not** copy and paste from the internet.

Your response will include the following:

- Introduction
- Body paragraphs
- Conclusion
- Max 1-2 pages double spaced or max 500 words, 12 point font, Times New Roman
- Margins are to be 2.54 cm all around (Microsoft default Setting)
- You will lose marks if your response does not follow these instructions
- Make sure you look at the rubric to see how you will be evaluated. (Ex. what to include in the introduction, body paragraphs, conclusion, etc.)
